| <i>Colchagua Valley, Chile. This exotic, sumptuously rich wine is packed with aromas of ripe tropical fruit and flowers. It is full bodied, dripping with juicy nectarine, melon and papaya flavours, finishing rounded and succulent.</i> | |
| 18. Riesling Classic, Peter Lehmann, 2011 | £22.50 |
| <i>South Australia. A vibrant, fresh floral notes and a hint of citrus. The palate shows great purity of fruit with a soft, moderately dry finish.</i> | |
| 19. Chenin Blanc Reserve, Ken Forrester, 2010 | £23.95 |
| <i>Western Cape, South Africa. Full bodied with a complex structure, this wine is bursting with flavours of dried apricots, pineapple and hints of vanilla and honey.</i> | |

| <i>Lazio, Italy. Grapey fruity notes on the nose and a smooth, medium-bodied palate with a slight almond twist on the finish.</i> | |

| <i>Rias Baixas, Spain. Fresh and balanced with pure flavours showing good mineral character, with a good length and texture on the palate.</i> | |

| <i>Burgundy, France. Opulent, rich Chardonnay with style and sophistication. Honey on the nose & nuts on the palate.</i> | |
| 23. Chardonnay, Trinity Hill, Hawkes Bay, 2009 | £25.55 |
| <i>Hawkes Bay, New Zealand. Grapefruit and melon are supplemented by biscuity characters with a light butteriness. The wine is rich and round, with soft acidity and attractive sweet fruit.</i> | |

| <i>Piemonte, Italy. Crisp and dry, with hints of ripe pears and a complex array of red and green apple notes; the finish is mouthwateringly refreshing and lengthy.</i> | |

| <i>Alsace, France. From one of the most historic producers in Alsace. This is their glug glug wine, it is fine with tones of lemon, mineral and lots of breadth of flavour.</i> | |

| <i>Burgundy, France. Fruit notes of apple and melon with underlying minerality. Dry, steely and rich, with a complex finish.</i> | |

| <i>Loire, France. Clean and fresh with enticing lemon and leafy green aromas and a palate full of citrus and mineral fruits.</i> | |

| <i>Elqui Valley, Chile. Very sweet ripeness on the nose, possibly red gooseberry jam and a hint of green pepper. Ripe fruit on palate with soft texture.</i> | |
| 30. Montepulciano Podere, Umani Ronchi, 2010 | £20.00 |
| <i>Abruzzo, Italy. Medium bodied, dry wine has a finely textured structure and ripe, plummy fruit.</i> | |
| 31. Douro Red, Quinta do Crasto, 2009 | £21.95 |
| <i>Douro, Portugal. Rich and spicy with ripe tannins and a long, smooth, velvety finish.</i> | |
| 32. Cotes Du Rhone Rouge, Le Pas de la Beaume, Cave de Cairanne, 2010 | £22.15 |
| <i>Rhône, France. Medium bodied and supple with a generous amount of succulently textured ripe forest fruit. The structure is soft and the finish clean and moreish.</i> | |

| <i>Victoria, Australia. Displays a complex nose, with a broad array of fruit and oak aromas. Soft blueberry fruit, spices and subtle oak, well integrated tannin and a dry finish.</i> | |
| 34. Pinot Noir, Little Yering, Yering Station, 2009 | £23.00 |
| <i>Victoria, Australia. Aromas of strawberry and red cherry fruit with subtle vanillin oak. Well structured and persistent with great depth of fruit and savouriness on the finish.</i> | |
| 35. Pinot Noir Hawkes Bay, Trinity Hill, 2010 | £23.95 |
| <i>Hawkes Bay, New Zealand. Classic, varietal characteristics such as plums, blackcurrants and cherries are evident in this silky textured wine, entwined with earthy, smoky oak notes.</i> | |
| 36. Merlot, Bogle Winery, 2009 | £26.75 |
| <i>California, USA. Subtle and silky, yet bright and intense, this deep red wine is multifaceted. Black raspberry and dark cherry great the nose, while the brighter fruit of ripe summer plum dazzles the palate.</i> | |

| <i>Burgundy, France. Juicy, ripe sweetness, cherry and chocolate flavours and a raspberry finish, with a touch of spiciness.</i> | |
